

Synergy

1. The interaction of two or more agents or forces so that their combined effect is greater than the sum of their individual effects.
2. Cooperative interaction among groups, especially among the acquired subsidiaries or merged parts of a corporation, that creates an enhanced combined effect.
3. A mutually advantageous conjunction or compatibility of distinct business participants or elements (as resources or efforts)
